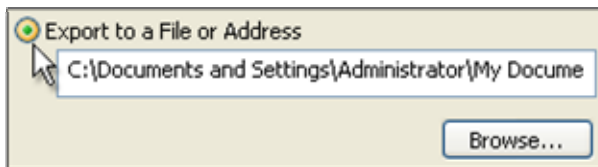
Exporting Favorites

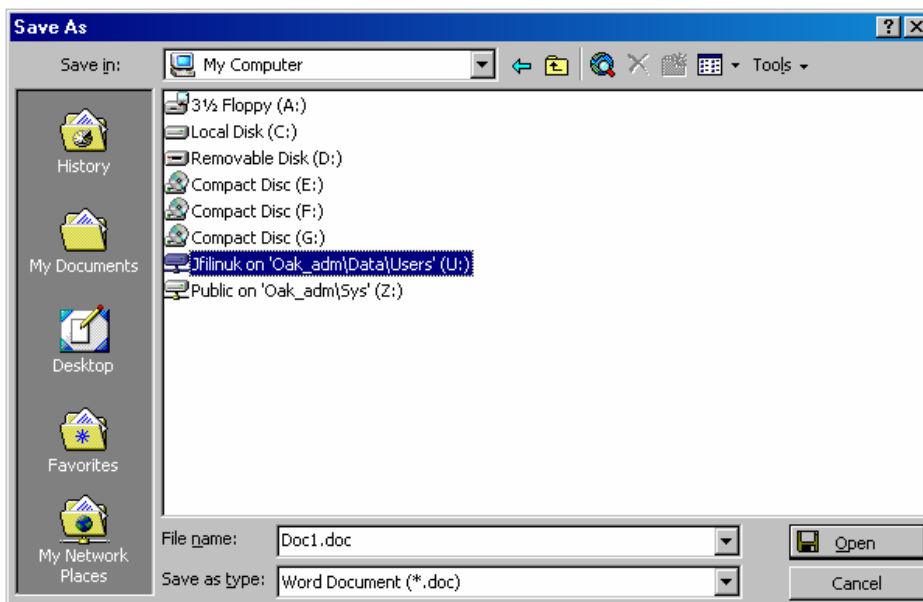


Export your Favorite sites to disk.

- From the menu bar select **File | Import and Export** and click on **Next**.
- Select **Export Favorites** and click on **Next** and **Next**.
- Place a dot in the radio button in front of **Export to a File**.



- Browse to your user directory (click on the **my computer** icon on the left and then 2x click on your **user directory**) to save your favorites exported to and click on the **Save** button.



- Click on **Next**, **Yes**, and **Finish**
- You should then see a message that says *Successful exported favorites*. Click **OK**.

You have just successfully backed up your favorites. To make sure you have successfully completed the backup check your user directory. You should see a file called **bookmark.htm**.
